

FHSAA Boys Golf Finals

Mission Inn Resort - El Campeon Course

NOTICE TO PLAYERS

This information supplements the FHSAA Local Rules and Conditions of the Competition. Further, the FSGA Championship Pace of Play Policy is in effect. Disregard any Local Rules found on the club score card or posted at the club.

FORMAT : Thirty-six (36) holes of stroke play. Both individual and team competitions are played concurrently. The low four scores per stipulated round count towards team total score.

TRANSPORTATION: Players must not ride on any form of transportation during a stipulated round unless authorized by the Committee.

OUT OF BOUNDS: Additionally, the rock wall at ground level behind the green of hole #4 defines out of bounds.

DROP ZONES: If a ball is in or it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found is in the water hazard (yellow marking) on #8 or #17 or the lateral water hazard (red marking) on #15 & #16, the player may, proceed under Rule 26 or as an additional option, drop a ball, under penalty of one stroke, in the dropping zone located:

- #8 - the forward tee, 95 yards from the green
- #15 - the fairway, 90 yards from the green
- #16 - the fairway, 70 yards from the green
- #17 - the rough, 60 yards from the green

LATERAL WATER HAZARD #16: On hole #16, where not painted, the margin of the water hazard is defined by the inside edge of the bulkhead (green side). The bulkhead is located in the water hazard.

ROCK WALLS: All rock walls on the golf course are deemed to be integral parts of the course. (no free relief)

OBSTRUCTIONS: All rock areas or flower beds fully enclosed by cart paths are deemed to be part of the obstruction.

SCORE CARDS: Score cards must be returned to the Committee immediately after completion of play to the scoring area located in the Vista Room of the clubhouse.

PACE OF PLAY: is four (4) hours and fifty-nine (59) minutes. There are **NO Warnings**. Each group is responsible for monitoring their own pace of play. To avoid penalty, groups must complete each checkpoint hole, under the allotted time, or within 15 minutes of the group ahead. Pace of Play checkpoints will be located on holes 9 and 18.

PLAY-OFF: A play-off for individual or team Champion will begin on a hole designated by the Committee immediately following completion of play by all competitors. ***It is the responsibility of the player(s) to be present for any play-off.***

DOUBT AS TO PROCEDURE: If a competitor is doubtful of his rights or the correct procedure during play of a hole, he may, without penalty, complete the hole with a second ball. He should inform his marker which ball he selects to count if the Rules permit. The competitor **MUST** report the facts of the situation to the Committee before returning his score card. If he fails to do so, he is **DISQUALIFIED**.
